NEW DAYPART PANEL INSTALLATION

Step 1

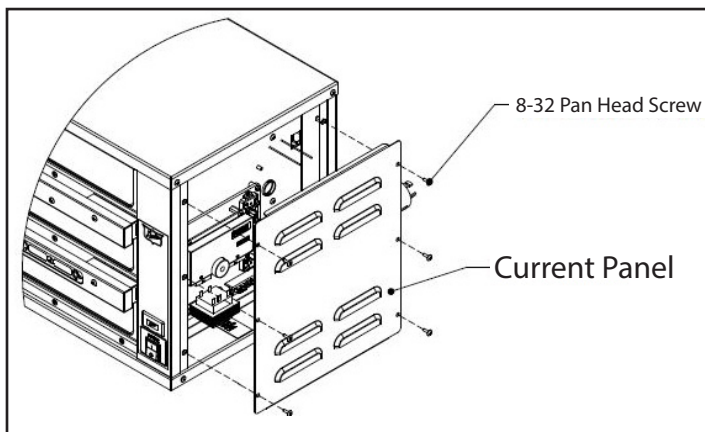
Unplug unit and allow to cool down if hot.

CAUTION

If not completed a hazardous situation which could result in minor or moderate injury.

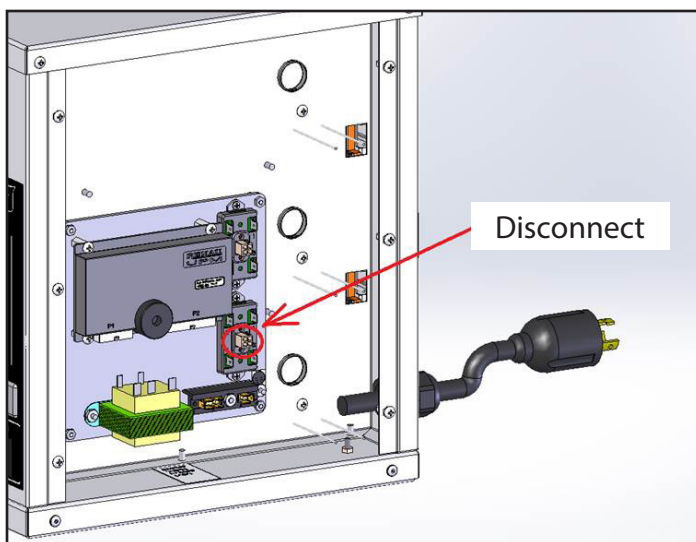
Step 2

On the control side, remove the six screws holding the side panel in place.



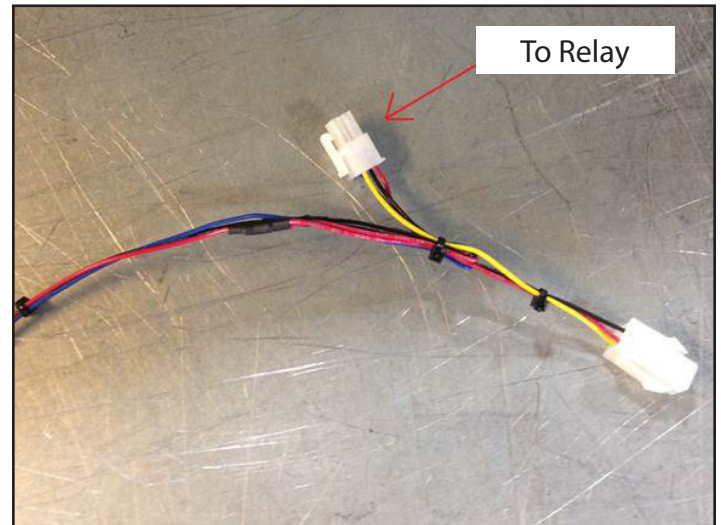
Step 3

Disconnect the wire harness from the lower relay on the control panel.



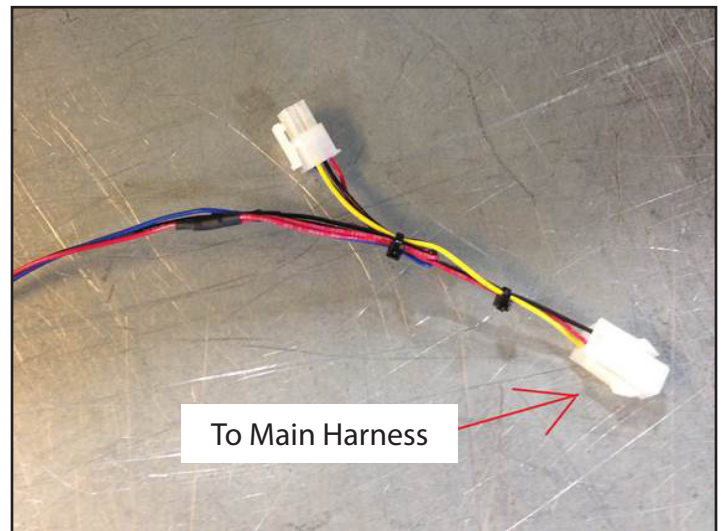
Step 4

Plug the smaller end of the wire harness from the panel into the relay where you unplugged the harness in step 3.



Step 5

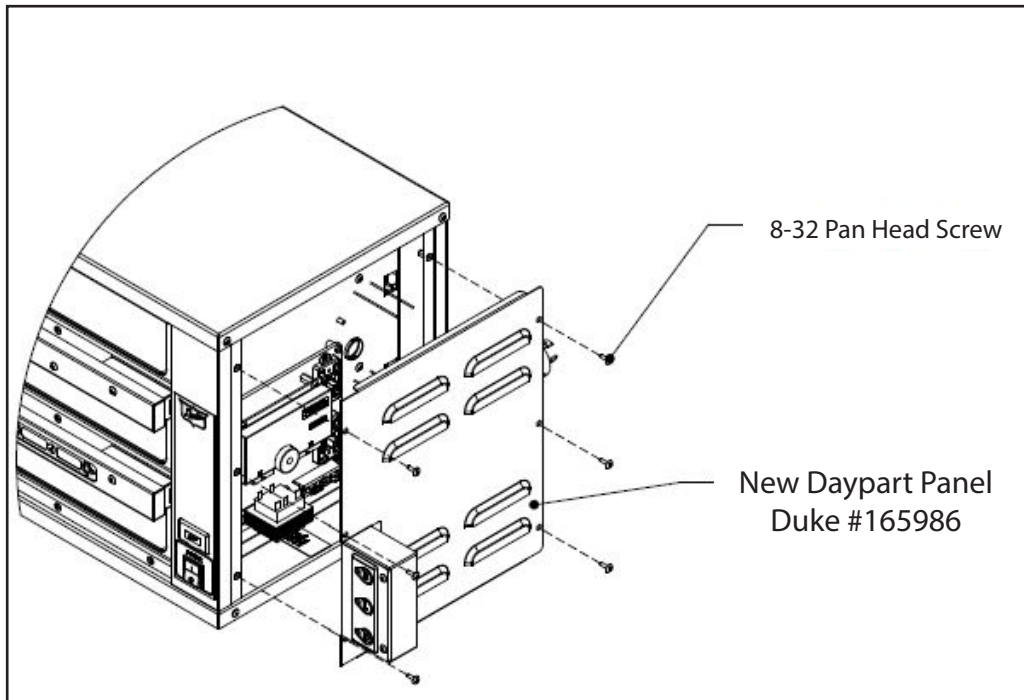
Plug the larger end of the wire harness from the panel into the main wire harness. The end you unplugged in step 3.



NEW DAYPART PANEL INSTALLATION - continued

Step 6

Making sure all wires are secured. Attach new panel using the 8-32 screws removed in **step 2**.



Step 7

Turn unit on and make sure unit is working properly and reaches setpoint temperatures. Cycle unit through dayparts to make sure recipes update.
