Inspection of Shipment

4187: Deluxe Apple Hacker, cuts apple into 12 slices.

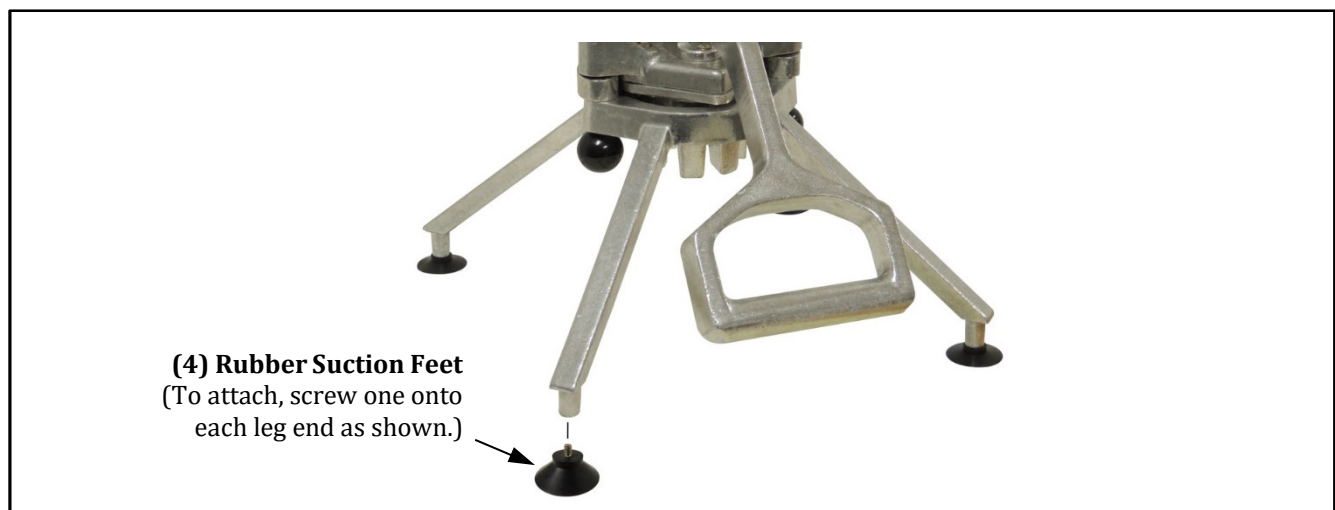
Items Included with this Unit

- (4) Rubber Suction Feet (for attaching unit to work surface)

Setup

This unit has been tested at the factory.

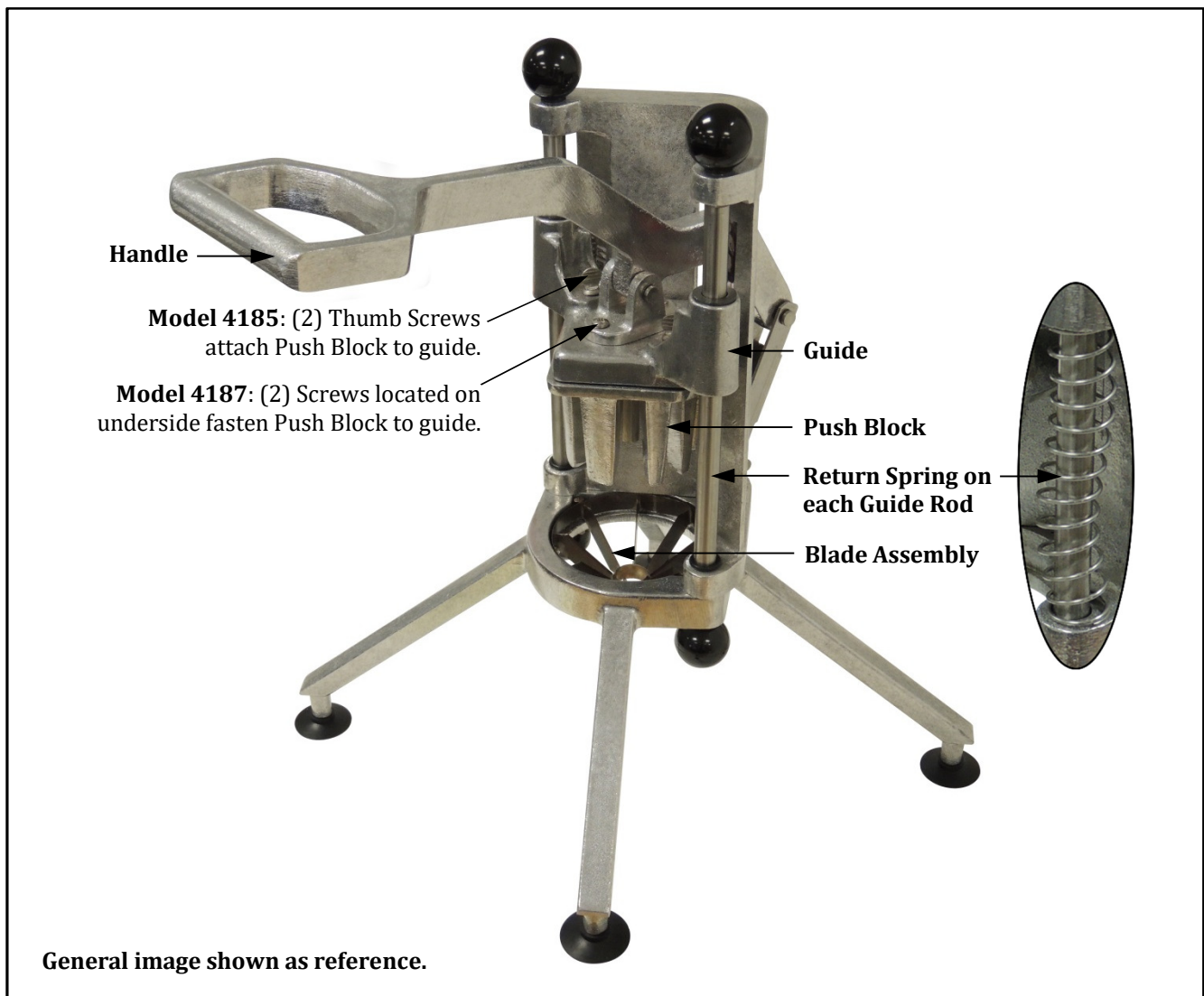
1. Remove all packaging and tape prior to operation.
2. Place unit on a sturdy, level base for use.
3. Attach the four Suction Cup Feet as shown in image below.
4. After setup, the unit should be cleaned prior to use (see Care and Cleaning section of this manual).



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The following instructions are for operating the Apple Hacker unit. Use caution when operating (handling) this unit, the blades are extremely sharp.

1. Place the unit on a smooth, level surface and attach it with the suction cup feet.
2. Place an apple on the blade assembly.
3. Remove hands and fingers from the cutting area and all other moving parts before attempting to lower the handle.
4. In a smooth motion, push down on the handle to lower the push block and force the apple through the blades.
5. Guide handle back to open position before releasing a grip on the handle (springs on the guide rods allow handle to remain in the open position).





Unit Disassembly/Assembly Instructions

The following instructions are for disassembling and assembling the Apple Hacker unit. Use caution when handling (operating) this unit, the blades are extremely sharp.

Use the Steps below to disassemble unit for blade removal and general cleaning or repair:

Step 1:

Model 4185: Remove the 2 thumb screws on the guide to remove the Push Block.

Model 4187: Remove the 2 screws located on the underside of the Push Block to remove it from the guide.

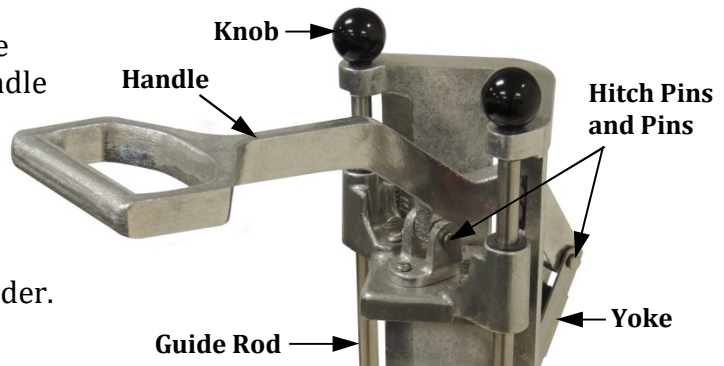
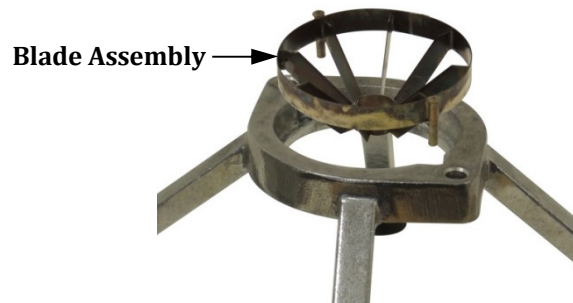
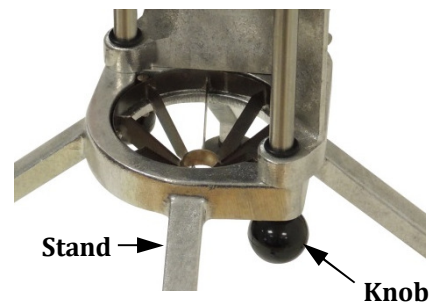
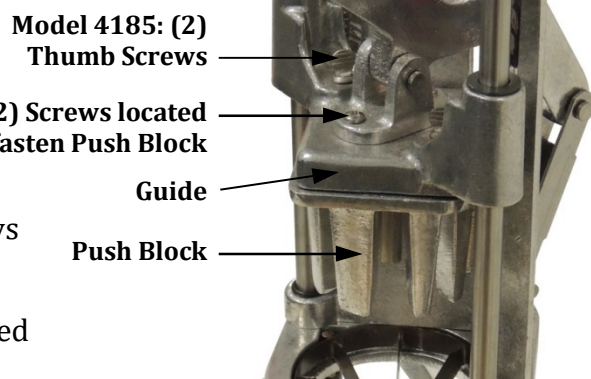
Step 2: Remove the 2 bottom Knobs securing the Stand, and then lift the upper portion of the unit off the Stand.

Step 3: Carefully lift the Blade Assembly out of the Stand.

Step 4: As needed, the unit can be disassembled further by removing the Hitch Pins and Pins to release the Handle and Yoke. Then, remove the upper Knobs to pull the Guide Rods out of the frame and guide.

Step 5: Reassemble unit in reverse order.

Care and Cleaning

Good sanitation practice demands that all food preparation equipment be cleaned regularly. A clean looking, well-kept machine is one of the best ways of advertising your product.

Follow the directions below to clean and sanitize the unit each day after use. (Reference the Disassembly/Assembly Instruction section of this manual.)

1. Make sure to clean all of the parts in order to sanitize them before each use. Use caution when handling this unit, the blades are extremely sharp.
2. The Push Block may be disassembled and taken to the sink to clean.
3. The Blade Assembly may be disassembled and taken to the sink to clean.
4. Clean the unit with a soft cloth dampened with soap and hot water. If needed, the unit may be disassembled further for cleaning, see the Disassembly/Assembly Instruction section.



DO NOT use oven cleaners or abrasive materials as they will damage parts of the machine.
5. Thoroughly dry unit, then reassemble.



Lubricating the Unit



When needed, lubricate the guide rods with mineral oil, food grade grease, or rub them with paraffin. **DO NOT** lubricate with cooking oil (it gets sticky).

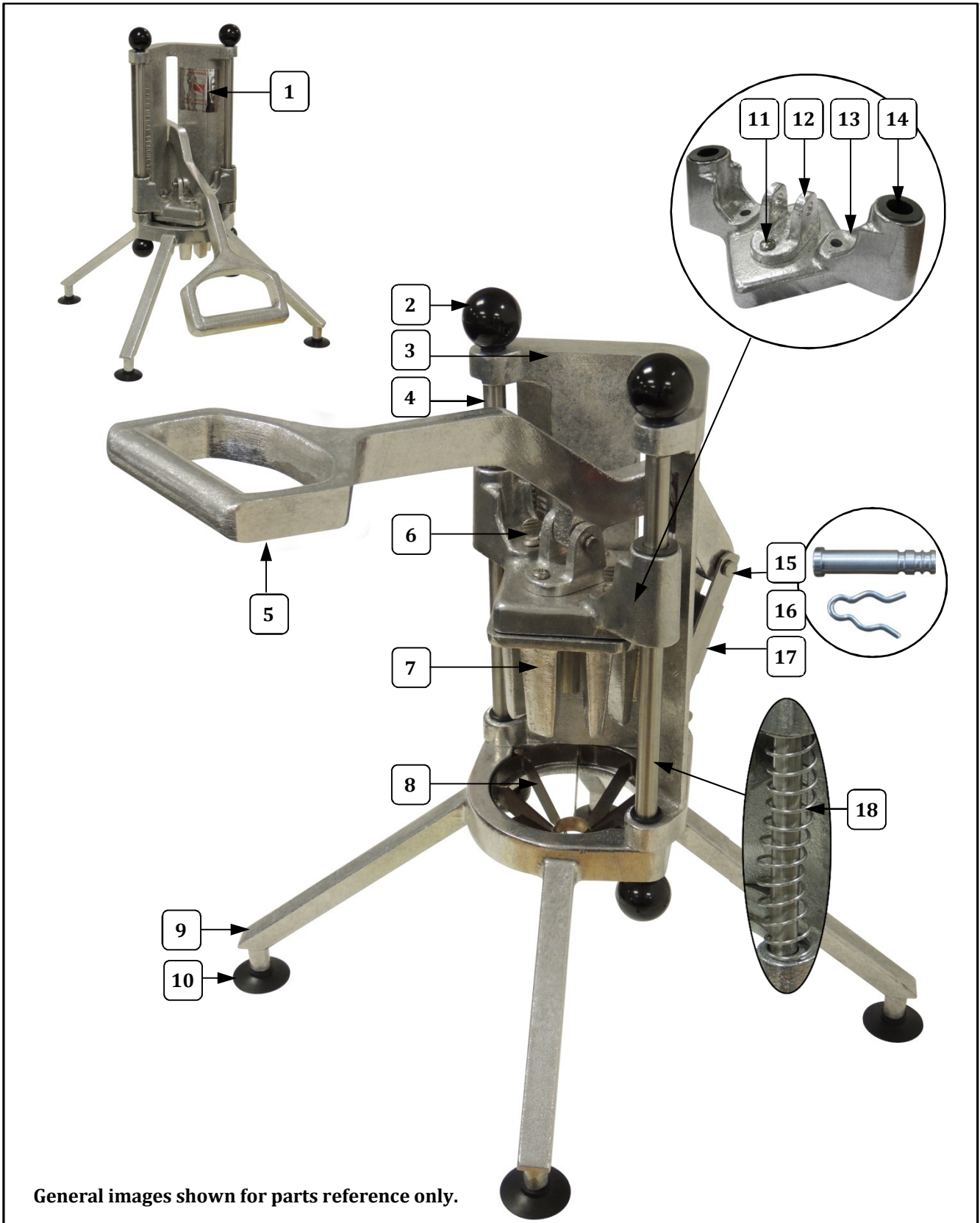
