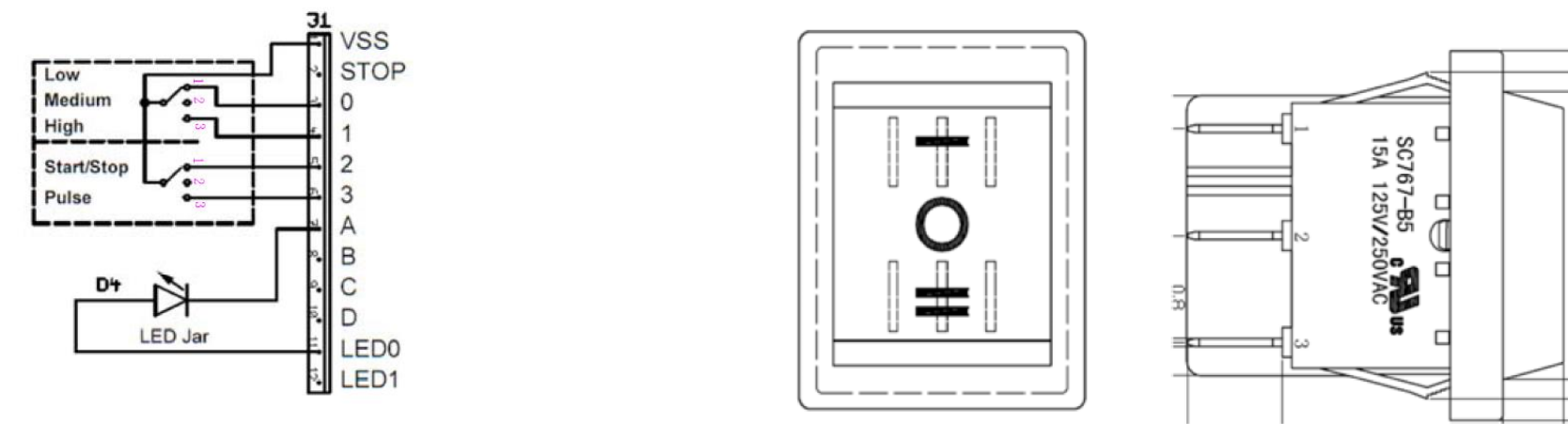


Wiring Diagram – GB33 Commercial Food Blender – 220-240V

- NOTES:**
- 1. Leadwire Terminals: Recognized Component separable (quick disconnect) connectors of the positive detent type, closed loop connectors, or other types specifically described in the text of this report are also acceptable as internal wiring terminals.
 - 2. Motor and Primary Power Switch wiring is recognized Style 3271/3273 appliance wiring minimum 16 AWG, with a minimum rating of 300V, 105°C.
 - 3. Motor hall affect sensor wiring is recognized Style 1569 appliance wiring minimum 24 AWG, with a minimum rating of 300V, 105°C.
 - 4. All ribbon cables on secondary side of Class 2 transformer are recognized Type 2468 ribbon cable, minimum 24 AWG, with minimum rating of 300V, 80°C.

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
